EXPLORE WITH YOUR FAMILY:

Teach your child the method of *Breaking Things Down* (BTD). When a situation or project seems overwhelming, break it down into smaller, more realistic steps. Remind your child that obedience with a good attitude pleases God.

Paul challenged Timothy to stand firm in his faith, trust God's Word, and serve Him daily.

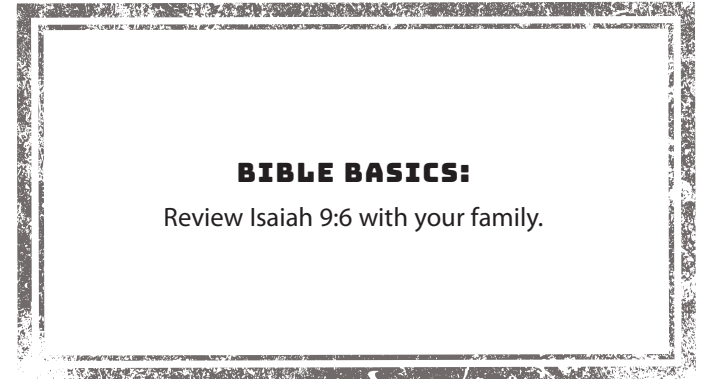
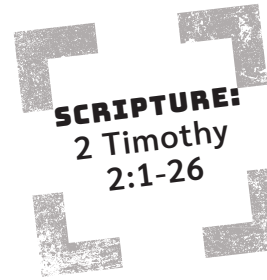
