Philippians 3:1-21
All things for Christ
Pastor Mike LeClaire

Paul warns the Philippians about false teachers who promote salvation through religious rituals like circumcision.

He explains that true believers worship in the Spirit and put no confidence in human effort.

Paul uses his own life as an example, showing how his religious achievements are now worthless compared to knowing Christ. His goal is to gain Christ, be found in Him, and live by faith—not by the law. He desires to know Jesus, share in His sufferings, and one day be raised from the dead.

Paul encourages believers to keep growing in faith, forgetting the past and pressing forward toward God's purpose.

He admits he's not perfect but is fully committed to the journey. He calls others to follow his example and warns of those who live for worldly things instead of Christ. Unlike them, believers belong to heaven and await Jesus' return, when He will transform their weak bodies to be like His glorious one.
